




# What "low impact" means to me



#### Plastic

- 95-99% plastic comes from crude oil
- extracted by pumping or fracking
  - Carbon dioxide and methane emitted
  - Pollution of groundwater
  - Destruction of habitat
- ethylene the basic component for the production of plastic



#### Plastic

- where it is necessary medicine, construction or tools (such as straws for the disabled)
- we use a plastic for an average of minutes before we discard it yet it shall stay here forever
- health concerns





# Afterlife of plastic

- can be recycled only 2 to 3 times before it loses its quality + necessary mixing with virgin plastic + downcycling
- Landfills degradation releasing carbon dioxide and methane (23%) – pollution of groundwater – oceans
- Microplastics bioaccumulation




# What is in the patch?

- 49% consumer waste
- 51% waste from the fishing industry (Seaspiracy)


#### consumer waste

- watter bottles + lids + caps
- cigarette buds
- cotton swabs
- hygiene products (tampons, pads)
- plastic bags
- single-use cutlery and straws
- plastic cups and lids
- balloons and balloon sticks
- fast food packaging

# Basic principles

- > Refuse plastic
- > Reduce single use paper
- > Reuse reusable tools, second hand, library
- > Repair clothes, shoes, furniture, electronics
- Recycle if there is not alternative usage through upcycling
- ➤ Rot individual or community compost, bio waste



# Zero waste shops

- food, drinks and drugstore products
  - eco, bio, local
- in eco packaging or to take in textile bags, glass jars, etc.
- usually many glasses and other containers there
- weighing your own container

  - also farmer markets



#### Food

- zero waste shops, farmer markets, supermarkets
- local, seasonal, organic, fairtrade

- food waste Zachraň jídlo v kuchyni (ENG)
- home compost or community compost
- mapko.cz (ENG/CZ) map of community gardens, composters and other places







### Recycling system in Prague




Cut up your food scraps when you compost so that they break down faster



### Gittemary Johansen

"If you [only] focus on plastic waste as your only outlet of environmentalism, you are going to feel more like a failure than not. [...] It creates this demonization of small things that are only parts of a much bigger problem. [...] I have accepted that being "perfectly" zero waste won't save the planet as much as boycotting polluting industries, changing politics, activism, education, green energy and cancelling hyper-consumer- and overconsumerism will. It is a bigger piece to swallow, but at least you won't feel like a failure trying."
